

White Oak Township Board Meeting November 11, 2024

The November 11, 2024 meeting of the White Oak Board was called to order by Supervisor Dorwin Marshall at 7:00 P.M. In attendance were: Supervisor Dorwin Marshall, Treasurer Brigitte Doxtator, Clerk Leela Vernon, Trustee John Kemler, Trustee Diane Graf, Zoning Administrator Katrina Griffith, and Bob McManaman. Trustee Graf lead us in the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion was made by Trustee Graf, seconded by Trustee Kemler to approve the minutes of the October 14, 2024 meeting. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Trustee Graf, seconded by Trustee Kemler to approve the minutes of the October 15, 2024 meeting. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Trustee Kemler, seconded by Treasurer Doxtator to approve the minutes of the October 31, 2024 meeting. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Clerk Vernon, seconded by Trustee Graf to approve the September and October, 2024 Treasurer's report. Motion carried.

Zoning Administrator Katrina Griffith gave her report.

Treasurer Doxtator explained that Dana Disposal out of Pinckney was less expensive than LRS so we switched our trash service to Dana Disposal.

Our internet service is slow and with the new cloud based tax program we need better internet. Star Link is \$359.00 for the equipment and \$140/month for 40G for a small business account. Trustee Kemler made a motion, seconded by Trustee Graf to switch our internet service to Star Link. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Trustee Graf, seconded by Trustee Kemler to pay bills. Motion carried.

Public Comment: Bob McManaman took the floor and thanked the board for voting to protect the Township by being included in the lawsuit started by Foster Swift. There are currently 70 townships involved.

Supervisor Marshall adjourned the meeting at 7:19 p.m.
