Commission members strolled the length of the park to review the list of repairs recommended back in June.

Weeds were well controlled. Benches will always need attention for undergrowth; several wooden benches need cleaning and painting next year.

Sumac still needs removing on north side border. Tree near south ball field has been taken down. Area around large hickory tree has been re-mulched

Playscapes and playground areas appear to be holding up well. Still waiting on several back ordered replacement parts. Sand replacement still necessary. May have to powerwash/stain King Kong equipment in next year or two

Gazebo has been repaired and has a new roof. It has survived the elements well

The pathway needs re-sealing, crack-filling and re-capping to preserve it

As Diane stated- the park is kept up well and was used a great deal during the summer
