As is always the case, weather played a part; Temperature 97 degrees- Lansing area

After raising the flag, we began touring the park to prepare a list of repairs

The gazebo floor needs power washing and staining; pathway needs patching, sealing and to preserve it- re-capping

Areas under benches need spraying as well as area around large hickory tree

4 inch pvc pipe in pathway needs removing; Dugout areas need weed spray

Sumac removal along north side is a welcome improvement (thanks Gary Cosgray and friend)

Sand for large playscape needs replenishing; bench near NE dugout needs board replaced and re-paint; Loose board on playscape should be replaced

New snap hooks needed for baby swing on large King Kong playscape; two vinyl fence posts have to be replaced and fence needs re-aligning

Possible tree replacement for tree removed last year

Library story book trail is up and running

Park commission is recommending an annual safety inspection by someone qualified
