

## White Oak Township Board Meeting October 10, 2022

The October 10, 2022 meeting of the White Oak Board was called to order by Clerk Leela Vernon at 7:00 p.m. In attendance were: Treasurer Brigitte Doxtator, Clerk Leela Vernon, Trustee Diane Graf, Trustee John Kemler, Zoning Administrator Tom Brimhall, Richard Morrison, Sam Curtis, Planning Commission Chair Missy Noll. Trustee Graf lead us in the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion was made by Trustee Kemler, seconded by Treasurer Doxtator to approve the minutes of the September 12, 2022 meeting. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Trustee Kemler, seconded by Treasurer Doxtator to approve the minutes of the Planning Commission from September 15, 2022, which includes the approval of the recommendation by the Planning Commission to approve the Special Use Permit application submitted by Allen Baker for a dog training facility for hunting coyotes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Trustee Graf, seconded by Trustee Kemler to approve the treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried.

Tom Brimhall Zoning Administrator gave his report. The board determined that \$600.00 would be an appropriate fee for Applications to amend our Ordinance.

Trustee Kemler has asked Ludwick Fence Company for a quote to add a gate by the shed but he has not heard back from them yet.

A check was given to Trustee Kemler to get to SAESA. When he delivers it he will get a receipt for the \$25,000.

Public Comment: Julie Brixie candidate for Representative in State Legislature 73<sup>rd</sup> district took the floor to introduce herself.

Richard Morrison stated that the GFI on the North side of the gazebo needs to be replaced. He asked if Jeff Steckelberg would take a look and fix it if possible. Motion to have the GFI replaced and check all the outlets on the gazebo was made by Trustee Graf, seconded by Treasurer Doxtator. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Trustee Graf, Seconded by Treasurer Doxtator to pay bills as presented. Motion carried.
