

White Oak Township Board Meeting March 14, 2022

The March 14, 2022 meeting of the White Oak Board was called to order by Supervisor Dorwin Marshall at 7:00 p.m. In attendance were: Supervisor Dorwin Marshall, Treasurer Brigitte Doxtator, Clerk Leela Vernon, Trustee Diane Graf, Trustee John Kemler, Deputy Treasurer Aaron Graf, Planning Commission Chair Missy Noll, Zoning Administrator Tom Brimhall, Richard Morrison, Ralph Tucker, Judy & Bob McManaman, Paula Warren, & Dan Wilson from Stockbridge. Trustee Graf led us in the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion was made by Trustee Kemler, seconded by Trustee Graf to approve the minutes of the February 14, 2022 meeting. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Trustee Graf, seconded by Trustee Kemler to approve the treasurer's report and presented. Motion carried.

Tom Brimhall Zoning Administrator gave his report. The variance issue about the 1.95 acres owned by Dorothy Steckley was determined to be an issue for the Zoning Board of Appeals. We currently have 3 members, according to our ordinance there should be 5 members. Tom Brimhall stated that Carol would be interested in the position. We will ask Denver Doxtator and Jeff Steckelberg if either one of them would fill the positions.

A motion was made by Trustee Kemler, seconded by Trustee Graf to approve the Planning Commission minutes for February 21, 2022. Motion carried.

We received a letter from John Beck from SAESA requesting funding that may be available through the American Rescue Plan. The letter listed equipment and the costs associated with the equipment that would help SAESA be more effective for our communities.

We received a letter from Stockbridge Township making us aware of their intent to update their Master Plan.

A motion was made by Trustee Kemler, seconded by Trustee Graf to approve the recommendations from CMORE Green for the White Oak Athletic Fields. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Trustee Graf, seconded by Trustee Kemler to pay the bills as presented. Motion carried.

Public Comment: Judy McManaman said she was not able to attend the last Planning Commission meeting and wanted to know what corrections they had made to the solar draft. Planning Commission chair Missy Noll explained all the changes. Dan Wilson from Stockbridge took the floor and informed us of the new Stockbridge Senior Center.
