

White Oak Township Board Meeting September 12, 2022

The September 12, 2022 meeting of the White Oak Board was called to order by Supervisor Dorwin Marshall at 7:00 p.m. In attendance were: Supervisor Dorwin Marshall, Treasurer Brigitte Doxtator, Clerk Leela Vernon, Trustee John Kemler, Zoning Administrator Tom Brimhall, Richard Morrison, Sam Curtis, Aaron Graf-Planning Commission, Clerk Vernon lead us in the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion was made by Trustee Kemler, seconded by Treasurer Doxtator to approve the minutes of the August 8, 2022 meeting. Motion carried.

Trustee Kemler questioned how someone could approve the minutes of meetings that they did not attend. We looked over the minutes of the Planning Commission and the Zoning Board of Appeals.

A motion was made by Trustee Kemler, seconded by Clerk Vernon to approve the treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried.

Tom Brimhall Zoning Administrator gave his report.

Trustee Kemler made the motion to approve the request from Blanche Adams on Dansville Road to use the Township parking lot on September 9, 2023. They are having a wedding at the residence and would drive people from the parking lot to their house. Seconded by Treasurer Doxtator. Motion carried.

The "Mutual Release and Waiver" for the Gailey's to sign regarding their fine for no permits for building their pole barn at 452 N. M-52 was approved by the Township Board and signed by Supervisor Marshall. There was some discussion about future incidents of the same nature.

We have not heard anything back from the insurance company on the requested approval to allow Brian and Trista Baker to bring a food truck onto White Oak Township property to sell food to people at games in the park and possibly coffee and donuts. A motion was made by Trustee Kemler to allow this use if our insurance company does not have any issue with it. Seconded by Treasurer Doxtator. Motion Carried.

Hayhoe is having trouble locating a paver that is the width of our walking path. Trustee Kemler stated that he may have someone that can repair the path. It was decided to contact Hayhoe and tell them to do the parking lot and not the walking path.

We examined the bids from Ludwick and Cleery fence to repair the fence in the park. A motion was made by Trustee Kemler to have Ludwick repair our fence. Seconded by Trustee Doxtator. Motion carried.

The Road Department has finished the contracted work on Columbia and Iosco Roads.

We received a letter from John Beck-SAESA- requesting that White Oak Township give \$25,000 to SAESA for necessary upgrades and repairs. Trustee Kemler made the motion to approve the request and send SAESA \$25,000. Seconded by Treasurer Doxtator. Motion Carried.

A motion was made by Clerk Vernon, seconded by Treasurer Doxtator to approve the PA 116 Application submitted by Andrew Crawford and John Kemler. Motion carried.

Public Comment: Sam Curtis stated that there were rumors of developers wanting to purchase the gravel pit.

Richard Morrison stated that the gazebo needs to be painted and the floor needs to be power washed and stained. Trustee Kemler said he would try to get us a quote. He also stated that Watters brought in sand for the playscape as a donation. Harold Kemler worked on the ball fields. And asked if Gary could now mow the north side of the park where it was brush hogged.

A motion was made by Trustee Kemler, Seconded by Treasurer Doxtator to pay bills as presented.
Motion carried.

Meeting was adjourned at 8:12 p.m.
