September 13, 2021

A motion was made by Clerk Vernon, seconded by Trustee Graf to approve the treasurer's report and presented. Motion carried.

Tom Brimhall gave his zoning report. There was some discussion about the SSC Roping issue. Their Special Use Application is not complete so the Zoning Administrator had the lawyer send their lawyer a letter. (See attached.) There was some discussion about the content of the letter and a couple members of the Township Board were concerned. It was agreed to wait until the Application is complete and then the matter will go to the Planning Commission.
